ORDER SETTING PRO HAC VICE ATTORNEY ADMISSION FEE

PER CURIAM.

At the session of the Judicial Conference of the United States held on September 23, 1997, the attorney admission fee prescribed in Item 11 of the District Court Miscellaneous Fee Schedule was clarified to reflect that it only applied to original admissions and did not apply to *pro hac vice* admissions. Accordingly, effective January 1, 1998, the Clerk is directed to collect from all attorneys who seek *pro hac vice* admission to the Bar of this District only a fee in the amount of Twenty Dollars (\$20.00), payable to the Clerk of this Court. The attorney admission fee prescribed in the District Court Miscellaneous Fee Schedule shall not apply to *pro hac vice* admissions.


The \$20.00 *pro hac vice* admission fee shall be submitted with the written request in accordance with Local Rule 11.1(C)(3), and shall be collected for, and remitted by the Clerk to, the Federal Bench and Bar Fund of the District. In all other respects, the fee schedule set out in this Court's order of December 5, 1996, remains in full force and effect.

All judges of this District concur in the entry of this order.
