This appointment shall be effective immediately and the appointments shall continue until otherwise modified by order of this Court or until December 31, 2005, whichever occurs first.

The Chairman shall call a meeting of the panel to review applications, to interview applicants, or to otherwise perform its duties. The Chairman shall exercise all the powers and duties necessary to insure that the panel is able to fairly and comprehensively review and evaluate all applicants for full-time and part-time magistrate judge positions in this District. He shall submit a written report of the Panel's recommendations to the Court as appropriate.

Although members of this panel will receive no compensation for their services, they are authorized travel and transportation expenses, reimbursement of expenses reasonably and necessarily incurred in connection with their duties on this panel, and subsistence for those members in a "travel status."

These appointments are made with the concurrence of all the judges of this Court, and this order modifies and supplants the Administrative order of May 19, 2000.
