O R D E R

UPON CONSIDERATION of the appointment of Judge Stephan P. Mickle as the fourth active judge of the Court, the case assignments of all the judges require re-adjustment. Therefore, it is

ORDERED, effective June 22, 1998, that all civil and criminal cases filed in the Northern District of Florida shall be assigned to the district judges as follows:

PENSACOLA DIVISION

All **prisoner** (510, 530, 550, 555); **social security** (861, 862, 863, 864, 865); **forfeiture/penalty** (610, 620, 625, 630, 640, 650, 660, 690); and **bankruptcy** (422, 423) **civil** cases shall be assigned on a rotating basis:

40% to Chief Judge Vinson

40% to Judge Collier

20% to Judge Hinkle

All **other civil** cases shall be assigned on a rotating basis:

50% to Chief Judge Vinson

50% to Judge Collier

All **2255 motions** filed in criminal cases shall be assigned to the district judge to whom the criminal case was originally assigned.

All **criminal** cases shall be assigned on a rotating basis:

50% to Chief Judge Vinson

50% to Judge Collier

PANAMA CITY DIVISION

All **prisoner** (510, 530, 550, 555); **social security** (861, 862, 863, 864, 865); **forfeiture/penalty** (610, 620, 625, 630, 640, 650, 660, 690); and **bankruptcy** (422, 423) **civil** cases shall be assigned on a rotating basis:

40% to Senior Judge Paul

20% to Judge Hinkle

40% to Judge Mickle

All **other civil** cases shall be assigned to Judge Mickle.

All **2255 motions** filed in criminal cases shall be assigned to the district judge to whom the criminal case was originally assigned.

All **criminal** cases shall be assigned to Judge Mickle.

GAINESVILLE DIVISION

All **prisoner** (510, 530, 550, 555); **social security** (861, 862, 863, 864, 865); **forfeiture/penalty** (610, 620, 625, 630, 640,

650, 660, 690); and **bankruptcy** (422, 423) **civil** cases shall be assigned on a rotating basis:

20% to Judge Mickle

80% to Senior Judge Paul

All **other civil** cases shall be assigned on a rotating basis:

80% to Senior Judge Paul

20% to Judge Mickle

All **2255 motions** filed in criminal cases shall be assigned to the district judge to whom the criminal case was originally assigned.

All **criminal** cases shall be assigned on a rotating basis:

67% to Senior Judge Paul

33% to Judge Mickle

TALLAHASSEE DIVISION

All **prisoner** (510, 530, 550, 555); **social security** (861, 862, 863, 864, 865); **forfeiture/penalty** (610, 620, 625, 630, 640, 650, 660, 690); and **bankruptcy** (422, 423) **civil** cases shall be assigned on a rotating basis:

80% to Senior Judge Stafford

20% to Judge Hinkle

All **other civil** cases shall be assigned on a rotating basis:

50% to Senior Judge Stafford

50% to Judge Hinkle

All 2255 motions filed in criminal cases shall be assigned to the district judge to whom the criminal case was originally assigned.


All criminal cases shall be assigned on a rotating basis:
