All panel members have been provided a copy of the Regulations Establishing Standards and Procedures for the Appointment and Reappointment of United States Magistrates Judges adopted by the Judicial Conference of the United States and have been advised orally and in writing of the provision set forth in § 420.30.20(d), restricting merit selection panel members from consideration for a magistrate judge position.

The Chair shall call a meeting of the panel to review the comments received and to otherwise perform its duties. The Chair shall exercise all the powers and duties necessary to ensure that the panel is able to fairly and comprehensively review the incumbent's good character, ability, and commitment to equal justice under the law. The Chair shall submit a written report no later than January 9, 2019, representing the panel's collective judgment on whether the incumbent is recommended for reappointment to an additional term of office.

By copy of this Order, the Clerk of Court is directed to provide administrative support, as appropriate, to the Chair and the Magistrate Judge Merit Selection Panel.
