McKeague of the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Sixth Circuit; as an Assistant U.S. Attorney in the Eastern District of Tennessee; as an *ex officio* member of the U.S. Sentencing Commission; and as an Associate Deputy Attorney General and Chief of Staff to the Deputy Attorney General at the U.S. Department of Justice. Additionally, Mr. Bolitho was a litigator at Jones Day and Cranfill Sumner LLP and an Associate Professor of Law at Campbell University School of Law where he was named "Professor of the Year" four times. He earned his Bachelor of Arts degree, *summa cum laude*, from the University of Mount Union and his Juris Doctorate, *summa cum laude*, from The Ohio State University, Moritz College of Law.
