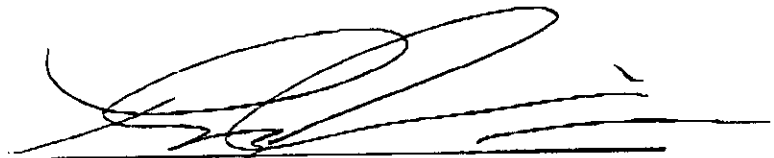


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The following is the policy of the Northern District of Florida for the use of cameras in a federal facility during a state court proceeding:

If federal facilities are used for state court proceedings, this Court's policy is to allow cameras only within the courtroom being utilized by the state court judge, but not in the lobby, hallways, or other public areas. There will be no lights, flashes, or disturbing use with the cameras. The actual utilization within the courtroom will be controlled by the presiding state court judge and at that judge's discretion in accordance with the policy of the Florida courts. Otherwise, if our policy is violated, the cameras will be confiscated. We will follow the Judicial Conference's policy if we are using state court facilities for federal court proceedings.
