

ORDER

Supplementing the order entered in this matter on January 31, 1990, and to renew the policy of this court with reference to firearms in the United States Courthouse, it is hereby ORDERED

That all persons, including law enforcement officers other than employees of the U.S. Marshal's Service, shall leave all firearms or weapons at the U.S. Marshal's Office for safekeeping before being admitted to a United States Courthouse. Law enforcement officers escorting prisoners will surrender custody of the prisoners to the U.S. Marshal upon entry of the physical confines of the U.S. Courthouse.
