No firearm or other weapon shall be brought into or possessed within a United States Courthouse in this district by any person except as authorized in writing by the United States Marshal and Chief Judge. Any such authorization shall be confirmed through written post orders from the United States Marshal to the appropriate court security officers. Law enforcement officers may leave firearms or other weapons with the appropriate court security officers or United States Marshal's Service for safekeeping before being admitted to a courthouse. Custody of any prisoner or detainee shall be surrendered by any other state or federal agency or officer to the United States Marshal's Service upon entry of the physical confines of a United States Courthouse in this district.
