Definitions:

- Ordinary** A transcript to be delivered within thirty (30) calendar days after receipt of an order.
- 14 Day** A transcript to be delivered within fourteen (14) calendar days after receipt of an order.
- Expedited** A transcript to be delivered within seven (7) calendar days after receipt of an order.
- Daily** A transcript to be delivered following adjournment and prior to the normal opening hour of the court on the following morning whether or not it is an actual court day.
- Hourly** A transcript ordered under unusual circumstances to be delivered within two (2) hours.
- Realtime Transcript** A draft unedited transcript produced by a certified realtime reporter as a byproduct of realtime to be delivered electronically during proceedings or immediately following adjournment.
