The Chair shall submit a written report containing the names of five (5) recommended applicants to the Court for consideration no later than October 14, 2011. The applicant names provided shall represent the panel's collective judgment regarding the best-qualified applicants for the position of full time magistrate judge.

By copy of this Order, the Clerk of Court is directed to provide administrative support, as appropriate, to the Chair and the Magistrate Judge Merit Selection Panel.
