The undersigned Chief Judge hereby delegates authority to the District Court Clerk and the Chief Probation Office to allow a government employee operating a General Services Administration leased vehicle to transport nongovernment employees when, in the judgment of the Clerk or Chief Probation Officer, the transport is appropriate for reasons related to the performance of official business.

This Order shall be effective October 1, 2013, through September 30, 2014, and thereafter is subject to renewal by Order of this Court for consecutive periods not to exceed 12 months.
