**ORDER**

On January 19, 2017, the Court vacated the previously scheduled deadlines for the completion of jurisdictional discovery 30(b)(6) depositions and for OPC to file its motion to dismiss on jurisdictional grounds because of a medical emergency involving OPC's 30(b)(6) representative. On January 24, 2017, the parties filed a Joint Proposed Agenda for the January 30, 2017 Case Management Conference, ECF No. 166. The Agenda proposes, among other things, a new schedule for the jurisdictional motion and related 30(b)(6) deposition, which the Court hereby adopts. Thus, the remaining deadlines related to personal jurisdiction are:<sup>1</sup>

- Completion of the 30(b)(6) deposition: February 24, 2017
- Filing of OPC's motion to dismiss: February 27, 2017
- Filing of response in opposition: March 13, 2017
- Filing of a the reply: March 20, 2017
