

Supplemental COVID -19 POLICY
For Entering Courtroom 5 and Judge Rodgers's Chambers

In addition to the general courthouse policy, all persons, including court staff, on-site contractors, and visitors, entering **Courtroom 5** or the **Chambers of Judge Rodgers**, who are not “fully vaccinated”, are required to wear a mask **at all times** within the courtroom and chambers, unless otherwise instructed by Judge Rodgers.

All “fully vaccinated” individuals are permitted to remove their masks **within the courtroom**, but must wear a mask in common areas of the courthouse, according to the general courthouse policy.

- Individuals are considered “fully vaccinated” for COVID-19 two weeks after they have received their second dose in a two-dose series or two weeks after they have received a single-dose vaccine.

These restrictions remain subject to review and will be updated as warranted. This is a temporary policy in response to the current state of the COVID-19 pandemic and out of concern for the health and safety of the federal judiciary and staff, members of the Bar, and the public.
